Playing logistics:

Each team may have no more than 12 players who are over 13 years old (born in 2009 or later). Certified copies of birth certificates for every player must be made available at the commencement of the festival. It is imperative to mention that we have invited a Pretoria club side to the K.E.P.S Water Polo Festival for 2022. As the club is relatively new, we have allowed them to have 5 x u14 B players in their side to help strengthen their team. We are assisting them with the growth of Primary school water polo in Pretoria.

Schools travelling from outside of Gauteng must ensure that they arrive in Johannesburg 10 March 2022. There will be a Coaches and Managers meeting at the Mark Stevens Aquatic Centre on Thursday 10th March. This meeting is compulsory for at least one representative per school. Drinks and eats will be available.

- Link to be filled out daily by all staff, players, and spectators
- Sanitizing will be arranged at entry and exit points
- Masks to be worn at all times.
- Social Distancing of 1.8 metres.
- If a player presents 3 or more symptoms at the daily questionnaire:
 - The team manager must contact the festival coordinator immediately.
 - The Medic will assess the player and administer a Rapid Antigen Test.
 - If the Rapid Antigen result is negative and depending on the symptoms presented: the player will either be released; or possibly be administered a PCR Test and held in quarantine until the result.
 - Should the Rapid Antigen Test or the PCR Test be positive, the individual will no longer be able to take part in the festival.
